

#### Relevance to VAS



It is the role of the UCC to promote the access to a variety of communication services as a key driver of the economy



Lately these have grown form basic voice services at the start of the last decade to a range of mobile telephone VAS services



The UCC role in VAS is most prominent in two forms; the liberalisation of the MNO and whole sale VAS markets



#### **MNO Liberalisation**



Probably the biggest enabler to the development of VAS services was the liberalisation of the voice service in 2007

This put in place a technology neutral licensing regime characterised by two license categories

The UCC has maintained a light handed VAS regulation regime with minimal regulatory overheads for USSD and Bulk SMS services

#### Management of Numbering Resources

**PROS** 

In line with international best practice, UCC adopted a new numbering range that increased the short code from 3 to 4 digit range. This further enables the entry of new services

In addition special 0800 numbers have been put in place for emergency communication that may include extreme weather notifications








# Opportunities in Broadcasting
