



















OUR GROUP:

The **Bukidnon Umayamnon Tribe** of the Philippines, with Certificate of Ancestral Domain Title (CADT 124).

An Indigenous Peoples Organization (IPO) for 29 yrs now, and is purely a Community-based Organization managed by the Council of Elders (COE), called the Bukidnon Umayamnon Tribe Kapu-unan To Mga Datu (BUKDA).

Our Project area is our **Ancestral Domain (AD)**, about **8,106** hectares.

The Overall Responsibility of the Project rests upon the COE headed by its Chairman.

Project Implementation Period: From April 2022 to September 2023





The Primary Objectives of Our Project are to:

- 1) Help in the participatory <u>mitigation of Climate</u>

 <u>Change Impacts</u> and accelerate <u>Watershed</u>


 <u>Rehabilitation and Soil Erosion Control</u> along the riparian zone; and
- 2) Generate sustainable income for the Indigenous Peoples (IPs).



Expected Significant Project Impacts:

- 1) <u>Provides small income</u> through labor on temporary employment of farmer-members (*which includes women*) and helps assure the availability of food and other basic needs for the family.
- 2) Was able to <u>plant 20 hectares</u> of vegetation as green cover, along the denuded **riparian zone** of the Pulangi River (i.e., <u>10 hectares of Giant Bamboo</u> and <u>10 hectares of Cacao</u>).

Aside from its <u>high Carbon Sequestration property</u>, the Giant Bamboo (Denrocalamus asper) will produce <u>edible bamboo</u> <u>shoots</u> starting the <u>third year</u> and the <u>marketable mature</u> <u>bamboo culms</u> starting the <u>sixth year</u> up to about 30 years (if managed sustainably).









Expected Significant Impact and Metrics:

- 3) The marketable products from Cacao Plantation will start to come during the middle of the third year from planting.
- 4) During the 18 months Project life, the resulting benefits for the farmer-members will be basically through short-term employment in the Project, and the sustainable income will start to come when the Bamboo Culms and the Cacao products will already be marketable.







NEXT STEPS TOWARD SCALING-UP

- 1) We have been applying for other grants from potential donors (such as; IKI, UNDP, etc.) and participating in Investors Rountables (AVPN / UNDP).
- 2) We have joined the AVPN's Deal Share Platform (DSP).
- 3) We have been exploring how to set-up a project on the marketing of **Carbon Credits** from the **Cacao** and the **Bamboo** Plantations (with VNV and UNDP's support).

BUT FIRST AND FOREMOST TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY,

- 4) We have to find funds for the protection and maintenance of the 10-ha <u>Cacao Plantation</u> starting the 19th Month until the <u>third year</u> from planting.
- 5) We have to find funds for the protection and maintenance of 10-ha **Bamboo Plantation** starting the **19th Month** until the **sixth year** from planting.
