2. Sea-Weed Farming (Maritime Islands)

- Opportunity cost (Tourism)

P-CBA COUNTRY TEAMS

- 2. Sectoral Teams

Reasons

- 1. Different Ministry objectives: e.g. Strategic Planning looks at economic implications of a project, MOF looks at financial, Environment looks at minimizing environmental degradation, Social Welfare looks at social equity etc.
- 2. Application Aspect DOE interested in CBA, MOF interested in Costing, Planning interested in Economic implications.

METHODOLOGY

- 1. Consultation with WOG/ Central Agencies
- 2. Use existing institutions e.g. PSC (GTC)
- 3. 4 days training vs. module diploma type training?
- 4. When? Before elections? between June and September.
- 5. Training Content depending on needs e.g. refresher vs. extensive CBA training.
- 6. Sustainability train the trainer, use electronic means, capacity building sessions.

OUTPUT

- 1. Capacity Building in government
- 2. CBA checklist 1 A4 size paper with all important questions for a basic CBA.
- 3. Mentoring needs are identified after the training and mentoring requests are forwarded for a specific timeframe. (Practioners of CBA in SIDS environment).
