Baseline assessments completed for 8 countries



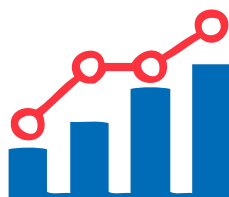
National Adaptation Plan (NAP) support to 6 countries including 7 NAP consultations /training seminars



6 countries supported in the development of Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs)



1200 persons trained in NAP and NAMA development



50 persons trained regarding Standardized Baselines (SBs)

37 projects approved and implementation commenced
