




#### ETF


- Article 13 of the PA establishes the ETF for action and support.
- Adaptation reporting in developing countries could be done through Biannual Transparency Reports (BTRs) and Adaptation communications (AC)
- BTR and ACs will inform the Global Stock take (art 14) in 2024

## Aligning approaches with Article 7 principles



Principles	IMPLICATIONS — WHAT DOES THIS MEAN IN PRACTICE?
1. Country driven	<ul> <li>Adaptation plans, strategies, led, designed and developed by national stakeholders</li> <li>Adaptation actions and processes should support national priorities.</li> </ul>
2. Gender Responsive	Adaptation should address gender-differentiated risks, vulnerabilities and impacts
3.Participatory & transparent	Adaptation planning, implementation should involve relevant stakeholders, and do so in a transparent manner
4. Addressing vulnerabilities	Adaptation actions and processes should target the most vulnerable people, locations and systems (including ecosystems).
5. Guided by best science & knowledge	Adaptation plans should be informed by scientific information Local and indigenous knowledge should be employed to understand risks
6. Supportive of integration	Adaptation should support national development priorities, SDGs and be integrated into wider development plans


