BACKGROUND


- Adaptation planning 'driven' by International and Regional Frameworks; i.e. UNFCCC and PIFFAC
- Focus was on developing NAPAs, enabling activities, national communications, institutional arrangements and project proposals





- DRM planning 'driven' by International and Regional Frameworks; i.e. Hyogo Framework and Regional Framework for Action (RFA)
- Focus was on developing DRM National Action Plans (NAPs), policy and legislation and implementation
- Existing institutional arrangements for DM modified to include DRR
- Pacific guide developed on how to develop NAPs

International, Regional & National Framework for DRM & CC








COMING TOGETHER OF CCA AND DRM PLANNING

- Growing recognition of synergies and overlaps between CCA and DRR/DRM
- Countries began opting for one plan for CC and DRM
- Came to be known as 'JNAP'
- Trend taken up at regional level with current development of <u>one regional strategy</u> for both CC and DRM

International, Regional & National Framework for DRM & CC







Strategy for Climate and Disaster Resilient Development in the Pacific (SRDP) - draft

Goals:

- Strengthened Integrated Risk Management to enhance resilience to climate and disaster impacts
- 2) Low Carbon Development
- 3) Strengthened Disaster Preparedness, Response and Recovery

Focus is now on the unifying concept of 'RESILIENCE'

Cook Islands: JNAP completed and formally endorsed in 2012

Tonga: JNAP completed and formally endorsed in 2012

RMI: JNAP completed and formally endorsed in 2013

<u>Tuvalu</u>: National Strategic Action Plan for Climate Change & Disaster Risk Management (NSAP) formally endorsed

<u>Kiribati</u>: Kiribati Joint Implementation Plan for Climate Change and Disaster Risk Management (KJIP) formally endorsed





Niue: JNAP document completed and awaiting endorsement

<u>FSM</u>: Nation Wide DRM and Climate Change Policy adopted in 2014. JNAP planning underway.

<u>Palau</u>: Development of a Climate Change Policy Framework (CCPF) underway. JNAP to follow

Nauru: Republic of Nauru Adaptation and Disaster Risk Reduction Framework (RONAdapt) under development. Linked to a Climate Change Policy Statement.





Fiji: JNAP process under discussion.

<u>Samoa</u>: NAPA in place and recently reviewed. DRM NAP in place and about to be reviewed.

<u>Vanuatu</u>: National Climate Change & Disaster Risk Reduction Policy + Implementation Plan under development

Solomon Islands: Preference to use existing development frameworks rather than stand-alone plan (under discussion)





IMPLICATIONS FOR UNFCCC NAP PLANNING PROCESS

- NAP Process needs to acknowledge the work that has already taken place in the region
- NAP Process needs to be tailored to add value to regional planning context, not to add an additional planning requirement
- Ways need to be found for alignment of NAP resources to strengthening and implementation of existing plans
